THU 17 JUL COLLECT YOUR MOTORHOME

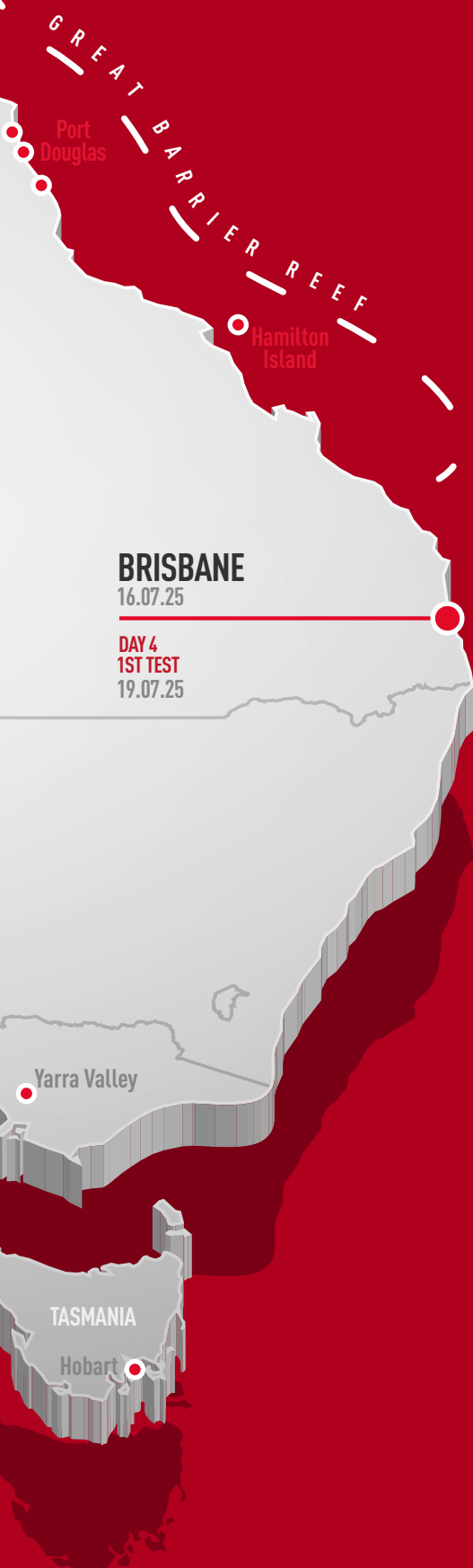

1 HR 21 MIN**

On day nine, head to Lamington National Park, a 54-minute drive away. Immerse yourself in the lush rainforests, ancient trees and spectacular views. This natural beauty makes this World Heritage Area an outstanding place to visit.

WED 23 JUL
**LAMINGTON BAY TO BYRON BAY:
2 HR 1 MIN**

Make your way to from Lamington Bay to the coastal town of Byron Bay, roughly a two-hour drive away, known for its beaches, surfing and scuba diving sites. Take the day to visit the iconic lighthouse, which sits at mainland Australia's most easterly point, making for some epic views. One of the best ways to see the lighthouse is along the Cape Byron Lighthouse Track. This walking loop is magical at sunrise and sunset.

1 HR 49 MIN**

TUE 29 JUL

LAKES ENTRANCE TO CENTRAL TILBA: 4 HR 6 MIN

After spending the night in Lakes Entrance, the next leg of your tour is one of your longest drives, so make sure you are stocked up with water and refreshments.

The journey to the unique village of Central Tilba, is roughly four hours, so you will need to factor in a couple of stops. Classified by the National Trust and considered one of Australia's finest heritage sites, Central Tilba is a must-visit. The preserved weatherboard shops along the main street offer a charming selection of art and craft, gourmet produce and antiques.

WED 30 JUL

CENTRAL TILBA TO JERVIS BAY: 2 HR 51 MIN

On day 16 make your way along the coast to Jervis Bay. Home to some of the world's whitest sands, the beaches of Jervis Bay are among Australia's best. Take a walk along White Sands Walk and the Scribbly Gum track, these interconnected walking tracks together create a beautiful walking loop.
